CORRIGENDUM dated 15.01.18

RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF SAFAIWALA


It is hereby notified for information of all the candidates who have applied for the post of Safaiwala under the Cantonment Board Amritsar that the said posts of Safaiwala are the vacancies of F-9 head under Military Conservancy Agreement. Cantonment Board Amritsar is a recruiting agency as provided under section 110 of Cantt Act 2006. The Military Conservancy Agreement is revised on annual basis and is signed between 'The President Cantt Board Amritsar' and the Government of India through the Officer Commanding the Station, Amritsar Cantt.

The relevant clause of Military Conservancy Agreement is reproduced for information of the candidates:-

"In the event of Officer Commanding the Station requiring the Board to undertake any service not covered by the agreement and the Board agreeing to do so or in the event of any increase in the Garrison demanding an increase in expenditure on conservancy services or any reduction in the Garrison, sufficient to justify reduction in expenditure, an appropriate modification shall be made in the sum mentioned in clause 8 of this agreement as payable by the Officer Commanding the Station. The amount by which the sum agreed upon by the contracting parties, shall be increased or reduced and the date from which such modification shall be effective will be based on the increase or decrease of load of work involved. In the event of reduction in work resulting in the discharge of certain establishment or termination of contracts entered into by the Board for supply of material etc. The Officer Commanding the Station shall pay to the Board compensation etc which they may have to pay as a result of reduction."

Ibid clause under notice may be treated as part of General Condition as conditions of service in the advertisement dated 25.10.2017.

In view of above, the applicants may note that the services of the selected candidates shall be liable for termination in the event of reduction of services at a later stage by the President of India (Hereinafter called 'the Government' through the Officer Commanding the Station, Amritsar Cantt). Hence, it is further intimated that the services of shortlisted candidates will be subject to the confirmation of the Military Conservancy Agreement entered into annually.
